The Australian Electoral Commission will hold a ballot at each workplace on Thursday, 14 March 2013, for the following offices within the Rail, Tram & Bus Union:

National Offices

National Branch Offices

- **Delegate to National Council from NSW Branch Tram and Bus Division (4)**
- **Delegate to National Council from QLD Branch Tram and Bus Division (2)**

New South Wales Branch Offices

- **Branch Divisional Delegate to Branch Council (Tram and Bus Division) (5)**

ORDINARY VOTING

The Union will provide me with lists of members eligible to vote at each workplace. If your name appears on the list for your workplace, you will be able to vote as an ordinary voter. The hours of voting are 7 am to 4.30 pm.

ABSENT VOTING

If you wish to vote at a workplace other than where you normally work, you will be able to obtain an absent vote at that Depot. Members who will be interstate on polling day should apply for a postal vote.

POSTAL VOTING

If you are unable to attend any polling place on Election Day, you will be able to apply for a postal vote. Postal vote applications must reach my office or postal address by not later than **21 February 2013**. Application forms are available from me at the address shown below.

IDENTIFICATION

Before any ballot material can be issued to you at the polling place, you will need to produce suitable identification in the form of your staff number or Driver's Licence.

Ballots for offices not exclusive to the Tram & Bus Division will be conducted by post. Ballot papers for those offices will be posted to eligible voters on 25 February 2013.
